CAMP 2023

Through the generous support of our donors, 225 children attended camp this year – a 15% increase over last year. In June, JF&CS held its first summer camp shop and the response was overwhelming. This was made possible due to the support from: National Council of Jewish Women of Canada, Toronto Section (NCJWC) donating Walmart gift cards. Other camp essentials were donated by Camp Tamakwa and Kits for a Cause, the Downtown Jewish Community School chesed project, and Dylan and her family in honour of her Bat Mitzvah.

Susan* fled an abusive relationship in order to provide a safe home for her three young children. She receives no child support from her ex and struggles to afford the rent for her apartment. Unfortunately, two years ago Susan was diagnosed with brain cancer. She has since had surgery and completed her chemo, but continues to have health issues. Susan receives a modest income from the Ontario Disability Support Program to cover living expenses, however, is unable to fund any extracurricular activities for her children.

Through our donors' generosity, her children were able to attend eight weeks of day camp while she continued to recuperate. Susan was also able to provide her children with new shoes and clothing for the summer, thanks to the NCJWC, Toronto Section gift cards. Susan continuously thanks JF&CS for their help and is so happy that her children had a wonderful summer away from life's stresses and were just able to be kids.

The impact of this giving may last a lifetime: Socio-economically disadvantaged children are at risk of “summer learning loss,” according to international studies (Quinn et al, 2016; Alexander et al, 2007; Downey et al, 2004; Heyns, 1978). Camp offers an enriching experience where children gain valuable socio-emotional skills (making new friends, being part of a team, etc.) that can powerfully contribute to future life success. Camp also offers opportunities for positive child development, including physical development, nutritious meals, and creative self-expression.
