Client Camp Tuck Shop

We were so excited to hold our 2nd camp shop from June 19-21. Clients came to the tuck shop at our Central office to pick up brand-new items for camp. With the support of our donors, we were able to provide over 150 children with brand-new duffle bags, sleeping bags, blankets, swimming gear and much more. Through generous donations from the Irving Bloomberg Family, Party Rock, other community gifts, and our new Mitzvah Gifts program, campers could choose from a wide array of items.

Over \$270,000 of camp subsidies were used so children and youth were able to go to camp this summer.

65% of campers attended day camps, 25% went to overnight camps, and 9% were able to go to special needs camps that support children with disabilities.

More than \$13,500 was put towards providing one-on-one mentors for 17 campers requiring additional assistance.

One-on-One Support

JF&CS has been offering one-on-one support to children with disabilities for well over 25 years. The one-on-one funding is an integral part of our camp programming, as many of the children who access it would not otherwise be able to have a safe and welcoming camp experience. The program has an incredibly positive impact on the participating families as the children are given the opportunity to experience all the fun activities that summer camp offers in a way that feels comfortable for them. They can fully integrate with children their age, fostering a sense of community, acceptance and friendship. The benefits reach further, providing needed respite for caregivers who can know their child is being appropriately supported.
